

ELECTIONS!!

Pursuant to the bylaws of the Skating Club of Central Ohio, an election for members of the Board of Governors will be held for the following expiring terms:

President
Vice-President
At-Large

The term for each of these positions begins on November 1, 2010 and ends on October 31, 2012.

Nominating Committee

A nominating committee of three members must be selected. The chair of the committee is the immediate past-president of the club, or if that person is unwilling or unavailable, a member appointed by the current president. Two other members of the committee are elected by the general membership (no election is required if only two members are interested in serving.) This year's chair of the nominating committee is yet to be determined.

The job of the committee is to propose a slate of eligible candidate for each open position. The committee must interview each interested candidate, investigate their eligibility according to the bylaws of the club, and propose a slate of candidates for election.

Members of the nominating committee must be full members in good standing of the Skating Club of Central Ohio, must have designated SCOCO as their US Figure Skating home club, and must not be planning to run for the board or have a family member run.

Board of Governors

Four Board of Governors' terms expire Oct 31, 2010 and are open for election by the club membership. Each newly elected board member will serve a two-year term that will expire Oct 31, 2012.

President (currently Tim Barber)
Vice-President (currently Mike Baird)
At-Large (currently Membership Chair Rene' Kotarba)

Junior Board Members

Positions are available for up to 3 junior board members! These members must be not more than 18 years old as of Nov 1, 2010. The members to fill these positions will be appointed solely by the nominating committee and will not be subject to an election by the club membership. These positions carry a one-year term and will expire Oct 31, 2011.

Candidates for all positions must be full members in good standing of the Skating Club of Central Ohio, must have designated SCOCO as their US Figure Skating home club, and must not be a member of (nor have a family member on) the nominating committee.
