

## Who Should Skate with Chiller Synchro?

We are looking for skaters and families who are willing to work hard, support one another, and focus on the success of our teams.

Skaters level Basic 3/or Stinger (Snowplow Sam) 3 and up are eligible to be placed on our developmental teams where they will continue to foster their individual skating skills while learning new techniques for synchronized skating.

More advanced freeskate skaters with moves in the filed or ice dance experience may be eligible to skate on one of our competitive teams.

## Developmental Teams

Our developmental teams are designed for basic skills and freeskate skaters ages 4 and up who are interested in participating in synchronized skating through a fun and relaxed environment. (Including Adult Skaters!)

Skaters are placed on teams at the start of the season based on age and skill level. A tryout is not required for introductory skaters to join a developmental team.

## Competitive Teams

Our competitive teams are designed for freeskate skaters that have begun testing USFS Moves in the Field who are interested in participating in synchronized skating through a fun yet competitive environment.

Skaters are placed on teams at the start of the season based on many factors including but not limited to age, test level, and tryout results. A tryout IS required for skaters to be placed on a competitive team.

# COME JOIN THE TEAM

The Chiller Synchro program is based out of Columbus, Ohio and is made up of four teams, two competitive and two developmental, who practice from August - April each year.

Our skaters find that synchronized skating allows them to share their love for figure skating with teammates in a fun and challenging environment.

Our program focuses on developing strong basic skating skills, while also teaching athletes about the values of teamwork, perseverance, commitment, dedication, professionalism, and camaraderie. We believe all of these skills are important in shaping our skaters both as athletes and as people.

# Synchronized Skating Team Definitions

All ages are as of the preceding July 1 competitive season. All team requirements must be met by the close of entries. For complete rules, please see the current U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook, Rules 9400-9530.

## DEVELOPMENTAL TEAMS

**Snowplow Sam Synchro:** A team of 5-12 skaters. Majority of the team must be under 7 years old. No skaters may have passed higher than a preliminary test.

**Synchro Skills 1:** A team of 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team must be under 9 years old.

**Synchro Skills 2:** A team of 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team 9-11 years old.

**Synchro Skills 3:** A team of 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team at least 12 years old.

**Open Adult:** A team of 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team must be 19 years or older.

## COMPETITIVE TEAMS

**Pre-juvenile:** A team of 8-16 skaters. The majority of the team must under 13.

**Open Juvenile:** A team of 8-16 skaters. All skaters must be under the age of 20. All skaters must have passed the pre-preliminary moves in the field test.

**Intermediate:** A team of 12-20 skaters. Skaters must be under 18 and have passed the juvenile moves in the field test.
